THREE levels

1. Federation Central Level Ministries (Proposed 14, 15)

2. State There are Provincial Governments (7) consisting of District Coordination Committees (*DCCs) 77

<u>District Division</u> (Mountainous, Hilly, Inner Madesh, Terai & Kathmandu Valley Districts)

* Hilly, Inner Madesh, Terai is RERP intervention area

^{*}DCCs have no Executing/Implementation Authority. It only acts as Coordinating Body.

3. Village Institutions, Municipalities and District Assembles under the <u>Local level</u>

- Metropolitan City
- Sub-Metropolitan City
- Municipality
- Rural Municipality/Gaun Palika or Village Institutions
- Wards

The number of Wards in a Village Institution and Municipality function according to Federal law

Classification of Palikas/Municipalities: Criteria Permanent Resident

- Mountainous District: Minimum 10,000 Population
- Hilly District(including Hilly of Himalayan): Min 40,000 Population
- Inner Madesh District: Min 50,000 Population
- Terai District: Min 75,000 population
- Kathmandu Valley: 100,000 population

Other Criteria: <u>Generated Internal Revenue</u>, <u>Urban Facilities and Infrastructures</u>

RERP related concerns in the Constitution and Acts

17. Fundamental Rights and Duties

(f) Right to freedom

Freedom to practice any profession, carry on any occupation, and establish and operate <u>any industry, trade and business in any part of Nepal</u>

51. Policies of the State

(d) Relating to economy, industry and commerce:

- (1) to enhance national economy through <u>partnership and</u> <u>independent</u> development of the <u>public</u>, <u>private and cooperative</u> <u>sectors</u>,
- (2) to achieve economic prosperity by way of optimum mobilization of the available means and resources, while focusing on the role of <u>private sector in economy</u>,
- (3) to promote the <u>cooperative sector and mobilize</u> it in national development to the maximum extent,

Matter Listed on THREE level of Power in relation to RERP

State Power

 Agriculture and livestock development, factories, industrialization, trade, business, transportation

Concurrent Powers of Federation and State

- Poverty alleviation and industrialization
- Employment and unemployment aid

Local Level Power

- Cooperative institutions
- Local market management, environment protection and bio diversity
- Agriculture and animal husbandry, agro-products management, animal health, cooperatives
- Collection of statistics of the unemployed
- Management, operation and control of agricultural extension

Labor and employment policy in the Constitution

- regulate and manage the sector in order to make <u>foreign employment</u> free from exploitation, safe and systematic and to guarantee employment and rights of the labour
- encourage to mobilize the capital, skills, technology and experience gained from foreign employment in <u>productive sectors</u> in the country.

Policies relating to social justice and inclusion

- Adopt a <u>single door system</u> for the establishment, approval, operation, regulation and management of community-based and national or international non-governmental organizations
- And to involve such organizations only in the sectors of national need and priority, while making investment and role of such organizations transparent and accountable.

<u>Metropolitan</u>

- At least min 500,000 permanent resident
- Yearly Internal Revenue 1 Billion(1 Arab)
- Facility of well managed Agriculture Market Centre
- International Standard Trade Fare Centre
- Technical & Vocational Education Institution
- International Standard Hotel

Rural & Urban Municipalities Functions, Rights and Duties

Patrolling local market centers

<u>Co-operatives</u> Local policy, plan, standard, guideline, implementation plan, monitoring including capacity building and development (LGO Act, PP 12)

Local Market Centre Management

- Local business, demand-supply identification, evaluation, pricing and export
- Market & Hat bazar management
- Business and Commercial Infrastructure Development
- Research and Data Information on business updated
- Coordination, collaboration with Private and NGOs
- Local Business Promotion and market management

Agriculture, livestock, agriculture production and management

- Local level policy, planning, monitoring & evaluation on agriculture and livestock

Ward Committees notable functions for RERP implementation

- Potential Mapping of Small Industries
- Promoting Small Micro Enterprises, industries and managing records
- Management of local market centre(hat bazar)

(pp 32, LGO Act 2074)

Village and Urban Councils

- <u>Subsidies</u> on specific programs should be implemented as per the direction given by GoN and Province Government
- Rural and Urban Municipalities can <u>implement</u>
 <u>Project and Program</u> that is of Public Private
 Partnership(PPP) or of Co-financed nature
- R/Urban Municipalities should <u>coordinate</u>, <u>facilitate and support in implementation of</u> <u>Federal or Province level Projects</u>

Duties of Rural/Urban Municipalities on Coordination Role

- Coordinating on studies, survey and program implementation
- Incorporating program and projects in yearly plan and budget of Local Level
- M&E system to be implemented as directed by Local governance

Province Council

Implements, collaborates, partners between Province and Local Level mechanism
